This unique trip deep takes us deep into the living heritage of indigenous communities and weaving traditions in remote Mexico. We will enjoy the honor of joining one of the last masters in traditional shellfish dyeing on earth as he “milks” the mollusk to dye thread purple. We’ll visit the weavers who make pozahuancos, or traditional wraps, with this purple cotton, travel to a distant Amuzgo village to meet some of the finest backstrap brocade weavers in the country as well as visit Mixtec villages where brown cotton is cultivated and young weavers are coming up with new ideas for their ancestral traditions. And always, to our south, will be the luring blue water, mangrove lagoons and sand beaches of the Pacific. This is a rare trip far off the beaten path, a glimpse into ancient ways in quickly changing times. Be one of the few outsiders to visit this land where traditions still live*. **(PostT-5)**
